# International Student Fees and Charges for 2019



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## Application Fee

An application of AUD \$300 is payable at the time of application. Except as prescribed in the Refund Policy, this fee is neither refundable nor transferable.

## Admission Fee

An admission fee of AUD \$2,400 is payable at the time of acceptance of the letter of offer. Except as prescribed in the Refund Policy, this fee is neither refundable nor transferable.

## Annual Tuition Fees

The school year is split into two semesters (study periods). Semester 1 comprises terms 1 and 2, and commences in late January and runs through to June with a holiday break in April. Semester 2 comprises terms 3 and 4, and commences in July and runs through to early December with a holiday break in September.

Tuition Fees and other charges, as described in the letter of offer, are payable on confirmation of enrolment for the first two study periods of enrolment. Thereafter, fees and charges will be payable in advance in two equal yearly instalments. Families will be billed 30-days in advance of the commencement of each semester.

All fees and charges are GST free and payable within 30-days of the account being issued and are subject to annual review and adjustment.

\* The CUE Big Experience Fee (approximately \$4,000-\$6,000) for eligible year 9 students is not included.

The annual tuition fee includes both curricular and cocurricular programs at the College. Domestic students, Australian Citizens and holders of Temporary and Permanent Resident Visas should consult the College website for details of fees and charges applicable.

## Health Cover

As required by the Australian Government Department of Immigration and Border Protection, new students to St Leonard's College are required to purchase private health cover for the entire length of their student VISA, prior to arriving in Australia. St Leonard's College will purchase this insurance at a cost of AUD \$560 per annum (or as advised by BUPA or the College's chosen provider) on behalf of the student and will invoice this amount at the time of the letter of offer.

Continuing students will be billed the annual amount of AUD \$560, and when their cover is due to be renewed.

## Homestay

Students who reside with a St Leonard's College Homestay family, will be charged AUD \$16,100 per annum. This fee is calculated on the student living with their homestay family for 46 weeks of the year and includes full board, three meals a day, internet access, local phone calls and laundry.

Homestay fees are payable to the College half-yearly and in advance. For details of our homestay program and other accommodation options, please refer to the International Homestay Brochure.

## Additional Expenses

Please note that further costs associated with enrolment at St Leonard's College will be incurred for the purchase of a school uniform (AUD \$600-\$1000), books and stationery (AUD \$500), and any sports or musical equipment that may be required.

The College also has a 'Bring Your Own Device' (BYOD) model of student technology provision. Students in years 10 to 12 are able to choose the most appropriate technology to meet their needs. Students in year 9 and below will require an iPad.

## Methods of Payment

Accounts may be paid by:

- BPay
- Credit Card – MasterCard and Visa
- Debit Card or electronic funds transfer
- Cheque or money order

## Refund Policy

Application and Enrolment Fees are not refundable if a student application is cancelled.

1. The Application Fee, Confirmation Fee, Health Insurance and Tuition Fees are refundable in full if a visa application has been rejected.
2. A Cancellation Fee of AUD \$1000 will be charged if a student cancels their enrolment within 30 of their proposed date of commencement.
3. After commencing their enrolment at the College, and where a term's notice of withdrawal is not provided, a penalty equivalent to one term's fees will applied.
4. All refunds will be made in Australian dollars and will be payable to the party who made the original payment.
5. The College will consider the reasons for cancellation or withdrawal in the application of this policy.
6. This agreement does not remove the College's right to take further action to collect any outstanding fees and charges owing to the College.
7. To claim a refund, the student must notify the Director of International Programs in writing of their intention to cancel enrolment and claim a refund. After notice has been received, the refund will be processed and finalised within six weeks of the date of receipt.
